

1 in your recommendation a resident requirement, are you?

2 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: No.

3 DELEGATE SOLLINS: Four delegates could come
4 from one county and none from another, under your proposal?

5 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: I think you would find it
6 very difficult to get in the upper area of the Shore a
7 sufficient majority in any one county to elect people from
8 that county for four slots. I believe that there is
9 a built-in residual vote in each of the counties that
10 will in the course of nature take care of a good bit of
11 this.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sollins.

13 DELEGATE SOLLINS: If we had 144 delegates in
14 the house in 1970, how many counties would have a delegate?

15 DELEGATE GILCHRIST: In all probability every
16 county would have a delegate. I do not by this pretend
17 to say that every county will have a delegate.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Sollins.

19 DELEGATE SOLLINS: As I see the figures, and I
20 want to get clarified, if I am wrong, Delegate Gilchrist,
21 at 144 members in the House, eight counties will still
