2 Recommendation No. LB-1, by Delegates Gilchrist, Bushong,
3 Anderson, Linton, Gleason, Della.

4 On pages 1 and 2 of Committee Recommendation No.
5 LB 1 strike all of Section 3.04. Composition of the
6 Legislature and insert in lieu thereof the following
7 section:

8 Section 3.04. Composition of the Legislature.

9 The General Assembly shall prescribe by law
10 the number of members of each house of the General Assembly,
11 but the total membership of both houses shall not exceed
12 one hundred and eighty. The General Assembly shall
13 prescribe by law the ratio of the number of members of
14 the House of Delegates to the number of members of the
15 Senate, but the ratio shall not be greater than four to one.
16 The state shall be divided by law into districts for the
17 election of senators. Senatorial districts shall consist
18 of not more than four whole delegate districts
19 or a multi-member delegate district represented by not
20 more than four delegates.
