5 a little bit better, but that is something for the future.

6 I think the faults of the past will lead to  
7 improvements in the future in the legislature.

8 I say when you tamper with reducing the size  
9 of the House you are shocking the people of the state of  
10 Maryland and that one thing alone may be a big factor  
11 in defeating the constitution.

12 I say that I worked hard, I was one of those  
13 who did not favor the calling of a constitutional convention  
14 but I do not think anyone can say I have shirked my  
15 responsibility since being here.

16 I have lived up to the promise I made to the  
17 people that I would come and try to get out a constitution  
18 that they could live with and would approve. That, Mr.  
19 President, I am trying to do. If I voted for any reduction  
20 of the House of Delegates or the State Senate, I feel  
21 I would be shirking my responsibility.
