

1 It was on this basis that we considered the
2 type of General Assembly we would like.

3 I would also make one further point: The issue
4 is not the representation of political subdivisions.
5 The issue is the representation of people.

6 The Constitution, this Constitution which we
7 are writing will rise or fall by the number of individual
8 votes cast upon the issue of whether we want it or not and
9 it will not stand by the number of voters in political sub-
10 divisions.

11 I would urge that we support the majority report.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Burdette, do you
13 desire to speak in favor of the amendment?

14 DELEGATE BURDETTE: Yes.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Proceed.

16 DELEGATE BURDETTE: Mr. Chairman, I rise to
17 say that I shall vote for this amendment and I think I should
18 say that at this time because the majority report quite
19 correctly lists my name as one of those voting For the
20 recommendation.
