5 Delegate Malkus?

6 DELEGATE MALKUS: Mr. President, Members of  
7 the Convention, we are probably fighting a losing cause,  
8 but my people, our people want us to keep fighting so that  
9 we will have some representation in the General Assembly  
10 of Maryland.

11 I think the Senate of Maryland at 43 and the House  
12 at 142 is not unwieldy. If the President of the Maryland  
13 Senate is opposed, wants to cut this matter down, if he  
14 cannot handle the job, I am sure there will be any number  
15 of candidates who are willing to try it.
