2 asking the Federal Government to have an earlier census
3 so we will not have to fight this thing out twice in two or
4 three years? I understand, this is secondhand, I under-
5 stand it is possible for the Federal Government to have an
6 early census. If I am right or wrong, I do not know.

7 THE CHAIRMAN: The answer to your question, I
8 believe, was given by Delegate Gallagher in his presenta-
9 tion of the Committee Report. I think he said the matter
10 had been considered and was still under consideration by
11 his Committee; is that correct?

12 DELEGATE GALLAGHER: That is correct. The
13 cost is 25 cents per person. We know there is a million
14 dollars involved. We are looking for other ways to make
15 the decision of the Constitution applicable to 1970. If
16 we want to find that way, it may well be that the 35-105
17 figure will be applied to the ¹⁹⁶⁶~~1967~~ census figure which
18 Judge Henderson suggested it could be or may await 1974.
19 That is something that the Committee has yet to work out
20 because of the problems involved in determining when the
21 information will be available or what other information
