9 DELEGATE SCANLAN: As Chairman of the Rules  
10 Committee, I hate to object to anybody's right to  
11 exercise his privilege of free speech, but I think we  
12 would establish a very bad precedent if we are going to  
13 permit members to make little speeches for every motion,  
14 especially when that motion under the Rules of Parliamentary  
15 Procedure of this Convention and under the rules of  
16 any parliamentary convention is an undebatable motion.  
17 I object.
