12 tion has available the Constitutions of the other states,
13 or if they are available?

14 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Taylor, I don't think
15 that the Commission has the complete text of the Constitu-
16 tion of every state. However, it has a number of copies
17 of a publication called the Index to the State Constitu-
18 tions, which have been placed in the library of the
19 Convention. This is an index digest of the provisions of
20 all state Constitutions arranged by subject matter, and I
21 think you will find in it just about the answer to every
