THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Taylor.

DELEGATE TAYLOR: Mr. President, the Personal Rights Committee was concerned about finding the fifty Constitutions of other states, and one of our members asked about forty Constitutions. I wonder if the Convention has available the Constitutions of the other states, or if they are available?

THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Taylor, I don't think that the Commission has the complete text of the Constitution of every state. However, it has a number of copies of a publication called the Index to the State Constitutions, which have been placed in the library of the Convention. This is an index digest of the provisions of all state Constitutions arranged by subject matter, and I think you will find in it just about the answer to every
