

1 DELEGATE BOYER: Mr. President, it is difficult
2 to top Delegate Sherbow's historic first announcement, but
3 we would like to take the opportunity to inform the House
4 that the General Provisions Committee has a historic first
5 to announce, that we have met and selected an elected as
6 our vice-chairman, Delegate Charles Wheatley.

7 The General Provisions Committee will meet
8 this afternoon, ten minutes after we adjourn here, and hear
9 from Monsignor Neumann, and possibly from some labor
10 representatives as to the constitutional guarantees
11 that should be in the educational part of the constitution.

12 Tomorrow morning we will meet again at ten
13 o'clock and at that time we will hear from representatives
14 of the Maryland State Teachers Association, perhaps the
15 Baltimore Teachers Union and from some private school
16 representatives.

17 As you can see, we are trying to cover all
18 phases of constitutional recognition of education.
