specifically to aid the teachers in the secondary public schools of the State.

In addition, a seminar for those teachers will be held in a few days to discuss this program in detail. As a part of this program, large numbers of school children will be visiting the Convention and observing its work throughout the next three months.

Other institutions and interested groups are likespecial
wise planning speical lectures, seminars and discussion
groups and visits to the Convention. For instance, the
Enoch Pratt Library in Baltimore and the Baltimore County
Library are jointly undertaking a very comprehensive program
of public information and education on the subject of the
Constitutional Convention and have invited representatives
of Baltimore City and Baltimore County business and community
groups to meet with library representatives next week to
discuss methods of accomplishing this purpose. Your officers
will also participate in this session.

All of these efforts will, we hope, result in the visits of numerous groups, both large and small, to observe the work of the Convention in the next few months. We have
