

1 house that the Committee on General Provisions is still
2 considering the important problem of education. As we
3 indicated before, we have broken this down into four
4 broad categories, and I am happy to announce that we have
5 tentatively completed the category of Constitutional
6 Recognition. We now move into the phase of Public Educa-
7 tion, when we have blocked out a solid week of hearings.
8 Hopefully, we can conclude this within the next week.
9 Tomorrow, the Committee will meet on what we call Board
10 of Education, and in the morning, we will hear from
11 the President of the State Board of Education, and the
12 President of the State Association of Local Boards of
13 Education. Tomorrow morning, we will hear from presidents
14 of local boards of education.

15 The Committee will meet fifteen minutes after
16 this Convention adjourns today, and again at 10 o'clock
17 tomorrow morning, sharp. Thank you, sir.
