the reason for the absence, not only on that day, but on all previous days. The record is being kept, and it can be noted at that time.

If the Convention desires any different procedure, and desires that in each instance reasons for absence be publicly announced by the presiding officer, it can be so indicated in the discussion of the report of the Committee on Rules and whatever practice the Convention desires to follow, will be followed.

I also want to call your attention to the fact that Resolution No. 3, introduced yesterday by Delegate Malkus and read across the desk, has been printed and is or should be on your desk. If any delegate does not have a copy of that resolution today, please let us know and the pages will see that you get one.
