DELEGATE SCANLAN: Mr. President, I believe the Committee on Rules also has a Fifth Report that I had hoped would be distributed to the delegates. It is our report on Delegate Robey's resolution with respect to the creation of a Committee on Public Information.

THE PRESIDENT: Just a second and see if we can find it. Do you have such a report, Mr. Clerk?

I am sorry. The report does not seem to have been reproduced and it was not received by the Clerk. It will be submitted on Monday.

DELEGATE SCANLAN: On that score, Mr.

President, Delegate Robey's resolution regarding the creation of a Committee on Public Information was before the Convention, I believe, last Wednesday, and Delegate Robey impresses me with the urgency of the consideration of his resolution. The committee has recommended a favorable report, with some modifications with respect to Delegate Robey's resolution. Under the rules, I think it would be in order at any time and we would like to consider it Monday, since two session days have passed
