general law in there, that would be fine with us. But it 1 really isn't quite a public general law, is it; a law which 2 sets forth a charter, and all you have to do is look at 23(b) and see how it is set up. DELEGATE HANSON: I am bothered by the way I read the section on its face, if it be construed to mean that the General Assembly may legislate individually for 7 each county not having adopted a charter; and I gather 8 from your response that this is incorrect? 9 That is correct. It is in-DELEGATE MOSER: 10 correct. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Hanson. 12 DELEGATE HANSON: Thank you. 13 Then I want to be sure that I am clear that 14 you mean that the General Assembly then would enact only 15 one option or only one instrument of government, which 16 would then be required for any county not adopting a charter? 17 18 19

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
