at Section 703 and this section which you previously ex-1 plained as meaning that one charter would be adopted by 2 the General Assembly for possibly many counties, am I 3 correct in saying that even though a county might be actively trying to get a charter together or instrument 5 of government together, that if it were not accepted by 6 the county people voting that the statewide charter 7 would then become operative on July 1, 1972? 8 DELEGATE MOSER: If it were not adopted by that time, yes. 10 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: All right. Going to 7.04 11 12

DELECATE RYBCZYNSKI: All right. Going to 7.0 let's say that the charter that the people are trying to get together and get approved by their county people is a lot different, maybe totally different from the standard form. Would the wording of 7.04, that is, an amendment to the instrument, allow the county to adopt a totally new charter, a totally new charter, not just an amendment to the state form charter?

DELEGATE MOSER: They could amend by adopting a totally new charter. The intention is to make this as broad as possible but obviously some of the provisions
