contemplates as far as, and the extent of the alteration of 1 boundaries as this Article provides with regard to these 2 three counties using them as an example. 3

DELEGATE MOSER: Well --

DELEGATE MITCHELL: We all recognize the needs of multicounty cooperation, but sometimes we think that it is enough and the fear is the fear of violating the political powers in the already existing political entities.

> Delegate Moser. THE CHAIRMAN:

With that addition, I am not DELEGATE MOSER: sure I fully understand the question but let me answer it if I may by example, and show you what could and could not be done.

Under present law, the way it is set up in the Constitution, for instance, it is fairly clear I think that if the voters in the areas surrounding Bethlehem Steel Company wanted to be annexed to Baltimore City, probably this could be done. That is to say, it would not take a referendum in Baltimore County, the whole county making a determination that they really do
