1 Does it answer your question? 2 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Mitchell. DELEGATE MITCHELL: For example, does this 3 article contemplate the erasing of the boundary lines of Baltimore City and the merging of it with Anne Arundel 5 and Baltimore County if the voters so decide? 6 DELEGATE MOSER: 7 I suppose anything is possible. You have to go through a number of things to get there. 8 9 You have to have a law of the General Assembly, subject to statewide referendum; then a county-by-county referendum. 10 It is not much different from the situation that exists now. 11 12 in fact, except it is more stringent. THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Mitchell. 13 In other words, Baltimore DELEGATE MITCHELL: 14 City can keep its political entity with its elected offi-15 cials? 16 DELEGATE MOSER: Yes. 17 DELEGATE MITCHELL: And Anne Arundel County can 18 keep its, Baltimore County can keep its, and they all vote 19 for a regional government to take care of certain tri-county 20 functions as you have suggested, water, sewage and the like? 21
