way by a proper parliamentary device that Mr. Moser could 1 be given at least a 10 or 15 minute break. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: I would suggest the simplest 3 device would be to end the questions. (Laughter.) He has probably pretty well covered the area. 5 If there are no further questions, we will let him at least 6 sit down. 7 Delegate Byrnes, do you have a question? 8 DELEGATE BYRNES: I do, sir. 9 Mr. Moser, is there any question, keeping in 10 mind lines 17 and 18 of 7.05, subsection (2), and lines 11 36 through 40 of section 7.06, is there any question 12 that the General Assembly might decide that they are 13 going to take from five counties, for example, the authority 14 to legislate in the area of, for example, sanitation, and 15 place that authority in itself as a governmental unit? 16 Put another way, to simply take from the five 17 counties certain governmental responsibility and place it 18 either in existing State agencies or perhaps create a 19 State agency to handle those problems? 20 MR.
