regulate the traffic in Baltimore Harbor from Anne Arundel County, Baltimore County, and Baltimore City, and have given it to the Maryland Port Authority. Without this provision they would not, without something like this -- they may not, I should say, have been able to do this.

THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Byrnes.

DELEGATE BYRNES: One final question: Directing your attention to 7.01 and thisnew beast called "civil"

pelegate Byrnes: One final question: Directly your attention to 7.01 and this new beast called "civil unit," as I understand it, incorporated municipality is simply a limited purpose, small local government. As I understand, civil unit is the same thing.

As I understand 7.08, both of them are totally, the new municipality and new civil unit are totally subservient to the county.

My question is the rationale and necessity of a new type of local government, keeping in mind the fact there is some reluctance on the part of many to add to this proliferation of small local governments.

DELEGATE MOSER: I think the question you ask points up something rather important. Your premise is not correct.
