

1 just want to know, when they say they speak for a group
2 or an association, that they truly do, and for whom
3 they speak. I think this is a little bit different
4 than the situation in the General Assembly. The
5 category of representative witnesses, as we call the
6 latter category, those who don't get paid, will be very
7 large indeed.

8 Then let's get to the question of the persons
9 purported to be covered by this regulation. We purport
10 to cover every person who is engaged to represent another
11 person, association, corporation, et cetera, as set
12 forth in Section 1(a), who receives compensation for
13 those efforts. That category of person must register
14 as an agent; whether or not he is just talking to a
15 delegate or writing a delegate or what have you. The
16 second category, category we have elected to call
17 representative witnesses, are those who don't, who are
18 not compensated for their efforts in advocating the
19 views of others, but who nevertheless advocate the views
20 of others.
