to abide by the regulation. This would be done after notice and opportunity for hearing before the Rules Committee. The Rules Committee would recommend to the Convention. The Convention would decide whether or not such a person should be penalized by being denied the privilege from appearing at further sessions of the Committee or the Convention, either to the end of the Convention or for a limited time.

We also, I might add this point, it seems to be relevant here. Delegate Morgan, who did appear before our committee, recommended, suggested that we exempt from the applicability of the regulation those witnesses who were invited by a committee to appear.

The Committee considered this at some length. There seems to be a dash of fairness in support of that proposal. On the other hand, it seems to us if we granted this exemption, in view of the promiscuity with which invitations have been extended to putative witnesses, we would be taking, I think one of the members of the committee, perhaps myself, said it is a toothless regulation, let us not extract the gums, but
