

1 it seems to us if we yielded on that point we would really
2 have nothing, because it would be a very simple matter
3 to get an invitation and no one would have to register
4 unless he didn't know anybody at the Convention and
5 would not be favored with an invitation.

6 We require reports, as set forth in Section
7 5, periodically. I won't go over the details. They
8 don't seem burdensome. If a man comes down once and
9 is reimbursed for his expenditures and represents the
10 views of others all he would have to do is report that
11 once. There is another slightly troublesome problem
12 that I believe Delegate Burdette, who appeared before
13 our committee, raised. We/required that after the
14 Convention has gone on to the final report required by
15 the regulation be filed with the Secretary of State.
16 We will be delighted that it be required to be filed
17 with the Secretary of the Convention but I assume that
18 once the Convention adjourns, he shall go home with
19 the rest of us and therefore will no longer have any
20 official status whatsoever. The Secretary of State,
