DELEGATE GALLAGHER: Mr. Scanlan, do you propose that the adoption of this rule will be retroactive, that is to say, will have any effect or impose duties upon those who have already testified before the various committees, or have in any way fallen under the purview of this statute once it is adopted?

DELEGATE SCANLAN: I am sorry to say, Delegate Gallagher, the answer to that is no, and I suppose if the Committee had been any more delinquent about getting this proposed regulation to you for your approval, that not only would it be toothless, but it would be faithless.

THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Koss.

DELEGATE KOSS: I would like to address this to Mr. Scanlan.

It is my understanding that he specifically referred to the individual who would testify once and then not appear before the Convention or the Committee again and that person would have to file only one report. As I read Section 5, it doesn't seem to say that. It seems to me to say that every month that he would have to file a report.
