I would only add, to DELEGATE BAMBERGER: read, in connection with the definition of l(a), which defines agent as person engaged or hired to lobby and says, including persons engaged or hired for an additional purpose.

So the answer to your DELEGATE SCANLAN: question, Delegate Gleason, yes, such a person would be covered.

The other question I had, DELEGATE GLEASON: if I may pursue the matter, is whether the committee considered in the case of an agent who fails to comply with the rule whereby the persons called before the Committee or requested to testify, whether the committee considered also the requesting of the employer of such person to come before the committee to so testify.

One, the Convention has DELEGATE SCANLAN: no power, I think it is a point discussed back in July to subpoena anybody or to require anyone to testify. We could invite the employer to come, and if he came to express his own views, he would certainly be immune from registration because he was not appearing
