1	in a representative capacity. It would be very nice, as
2	Delegate Bamberger and the sub-committee reminded us
3	if we had the power to reach out and some way get out
4	those who employ the agents. I am sure I am not letting
5	any secrets out but there have been a number of
6	organizations that have been beseiging the delegates
7	with full blown copies of proposed constitutions,
8	and other matters, and it would be very nice if we
9	had a way of finding out just who all these people are,
10	what they represent, how much money they are spending
11	in the publicity effort, but the statute is silent on
12	that. It gives us no powers to get there and so I am
13	afraid that our answer there again is there is not much
14	we can do about that, and as I said, maybe this is the
15	regulation, you create a net to catch gnats but the
16	wasps go free. Mr. Bamberger, do you have anything
17	else?
