2 governments, for instance, who may be advising and lobbying
3 in their fashion in a category other than the committee
4 on which they would serve?

5 DELEGATE SCANLAN: Senator Della raised this
6 with us. The answer is no. If you are a delegate to
7 this Convention, you are here and there is nothing
8 more you have to do, just vote your conscience.

9 THE PRESIDENT: Are there any other questions
10 for clarification? Delegate Kiefer?

11 DELEGATE KIEFER: Delegate Scanlan, I have a
12 letter here from an attorney representing a commercial
13 group or organization, and specifically written to me,
14 and advocating a particular proposition. Would this
15 be considered requiring a registration by this particular
16 person?

17 DELEGATE SCANLAN: Delegate Kiefer, I
18 couldn't answer it until I had determined, one, whether
19 the attorney is just advocating his own point of view.
20 If he is, let me just take a possible alternative
21 hypothetically, one, if he is advocating his own views,
