

1 In that connection we tried to get how
2 many people were required, judges, but it varies in juris-
3 diction depending upon the nature and culture of the area.
4 Obviously an arterial highway through a small populated
5 area can generate a lot of traffic tickets.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Blair.

7 DELEGATE BLAIR: My question is directed
8 mostly to the question of what the financial cost would be
9 to man these district courts.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Mudd.

11 DELEGATE MUDD: May I refer that to the chair-
12 man of our subcommittee, Mr. Chairman, who may have the
13 facts and figures with him?

14 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Bradshaw, can you
15 respond to the inquiry from Delegate Blair?

16 DELEGATE BRADSHAW: Yes, Mr. Chairman. We
17 sought out the assistance of the fiscal bureau, and Mr.
18 O'Dell Smith of that bureau was assigned with
19 Dr. Cooper to develop factual information which we might
20 find useful.

21 We have a vast amount of research material,
