3 WHEREAS, after having been read for the first  
4 time, the proper committee shall have to consider, act  
5 upon, or pass over such proposal or recommendation, and

6 WHEREAS, in order to give proper consideration  
7 to such proposals and recommendations, each delegate  
8 should be advised of the financial ramifications thereof,

9 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Con-  
10 stitutional Convention, that beginning Friday, Septem-  
11 ber 29, 1967, each delegate proposal and substantive  
12 committee recommendation regarding a fiscal program be  
13 accompanied with a memorandum setting forth the monetary  
14 budget required by the fiscal program, and if a similar  
15 program now exists, a comparative cost study of the pro-  
16 posed program with the program now in existence.
