DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: Yes, sir.

We have run into a problem that can cause us some embarrassment outside by reason of requests to outside agencies beyond the State for materials being made directly by committee personnel. In a particular instance, a request which required a good bit of research and digging and additional printing by the Government Printing Office was addressed by personnel of two separate committees to the two United States senators separately. Each spent a great deal of time in obtaining exactly the same material. They were a little disconcerted to find they were duplicating the efforts. May we, therefore, request that all requests for materials from outside agencies, either State agencies or agencies outside the
