

1 part of a memorandum which was requested by the Convention  
2 some days ago, which is a memorandum assigning for pur-  
3 poses of study and consideration to the various committees  
4 all the provisions of the present Constitution. This is  
5 called the President's Memorandum No. 13. It comprises  
6 presently four pages. There are six additional pages  
7 which have not been reproduced but have nothing different.  
8 It is merely a restatement of the same material on these  
9 four pages by committees, so don't bother to look through  
10 and pick out the assignments of your particular committees  
11 This has already been done. As soon as it can be dup-  
12 licated, you will receive the additional sheets, which  
13 we will make available for you.

14 Just one word about this. In order to not dif-  
15 fuse responsibility, assignments have been made to only  
16 one committee. In some instances, this has required that  
17 an existing section be assigned to committees, but not  
18 the entire section so assigned, but parts of a section  
19 assigned to a committee. In addition, there are some  
20 instances where primary responsibility for a section ought  
21 to be in one committee, but one or more other committees
