2 This is not a very long length of time; so if
3 it is at all possible, if we could have some people
4 there from the Baltimore City delegation, we could
5 do it today.

6 THE PRESIDENT: Let me make this suggestion,
7 Delegate Rybczynski. I think the only room available
8 to the Convention that is sufficiently large to accommodate
9 all the delegates from Baltimore City is the room which
10 the Convention calls its Number One Hearing Room, and which
11 the Legislature calls the Baltimore City Delegation Room.
12 I would suggest, therefore, that all delegates from
13 Baltimore City who are so inclined immediately after
14 adjournment today, meet with you in the Hearing Room in
15 the basement of the Shaw House. It is not in use this
16 afternoon. May I further suggest that if you desire to
17 use that room for such meetings, you speak to the Secre-
18 tary of the Convention because it will be used fairly
19 often from now on as a hearing room.

20 DELEGATE RYBCZYNSKI: May I further suggest,
21 Mr. President, that the two chairmen who announced meetings
