

1 cogency that the phrase "as determined by the rules of the
2 Convention," appearing in the next to last line of Section
3 1 of Chapter 5, refers only to a determination of what
4 is an authorized committee or an authorized sub-committee,
5 or an authorized session of the Convention.

6 On the other hand it can be read broadly,
7 as your committee has elected to read it. The language
8 can be read broadly to modify the whole sentence and
9 to make it clear that this Convention has a rule-making
10 authority to deal with the subject.

11 Let me say at the outset, the standard that
12 we have selected is a clear and reasonably simple
13 standard, and also as I will indicate in a minute,
14 represents the committee's view that the standard
15 be a strict one. In brief, we propose that if a
16 delegate is present at either a session of the Convention
17 or a meeting of the committee, or sub-committee of the
18 Convention on a particular day, then he is present for
19 the purpose of being entitled to his \$25 expenditure
20 or payment. On the other hand, if he is not in
21 attendance at any of those enumerated, that is, either
