

1 a session of the Convention or a committee meeting or
2 a sub-committee meeting on a particular day, he is not
3 entitled to receive his \$25 expenditure.

4 With respect to whether or not a person may
5 be excused and thus safe first from ~~first~~ the penalty
6 of the \$15 deduction from his salary, the committee
7 has adopted what we believe is a fairly stringent rule.

8 We propose that a delegate shall be excused
9 by the President from attendance at sessions of
10 the Convention or meetings of any authorized committee
11 or sub-committee thereof, due to illness, death in the
12 immediate family, or other reasons beyond the control
13 of the delegate, and the excused absence shall be
14 entered upon the minutes.

15 This we hope will be a rather strict
16 standard to be applied by the President. It would be
17 very hard to not give him any discretion thereon.
18 On the other hand, we are sympathetic with the President's
19 view and I think the view of most of us that not a
20 great deal of discretion be vested in him in this manner.
21 I would say we all agree the practice we hope will
