2 have been hopefully excused; their cases have been  
3 postponed, pursuant to the request of the Chief Judge  
4 of the Court of Appeals, so therefore there shouldn't  
5 be too many instances of that arising. However, it is  
6 possible a man would have a case before a Federal  
7 agency and for one reason or another it was absolutely  
8 impossible to postpone it or the client would only  
9 go on with him as his attorney. Again it is a case  
10 with a little discretion perhaps the man could be  
11 excused.
