8 elected fairly strict standards.

9 The question arose as to whether or not a
10 man, or several of the delegates were sent by their
11 chairman as a sub-committee to say, to go to New York
12 to get information relative to the work of their sub-
13 committee, would they be entitled to the \$25 a day.
14 Certainly they would, in your committee's views and
15 if the expenditure was greater than \$25, I think they
16 would be entitled to the difference to supplement the
17 difference between the \$25 to which they are entitled,
18 and the actual amount of expenses that they may have
19 incurred on the business of the Convention. So in the
20 end, we have a strict standard. We hope it will be
21 applied in a manner that will be satisfactory, just
