

1 as Justice Holmes put it in another context, there
2 has to be room to play in the joints. We don't mean
3 by the joints the Maryland Inn, but I think this standard
4 is a good one. One is always confronted with the
5 inadequacy of language and the difficulty of anticipat-
6 ing all the hypotheticals that could occur. We are
7 somewhat bolstered by the informal opinion of the
8 Attorney General that the rules are within the power of
9 the Convention and satisfies sufficiently from a
10 legal point of view. There might have been other ways
11 to do it, other standards that would accomplish the
12 same result but we believe this one administered with
13 common sense, and we know the President possesses that,
14 will suffice to get us through the three or four-month
15 period without any real squabbles, without any real
16 abuses, and with all the delegates continuing to attend
17 their work sessions as you have.

18 I therefore -- I have a point. There has
19 been a misspelling throughout. Some one of the
20 secretarial staff could not spell the word attendance.

respect since you already have a resolution passed last
