6 DELEGATE STORM: Mr. President, suppose the
7 meeting which you attend or the meetings which you
8 attend are public relations meetings for Lions, Rotary
9 and other clubs that want you to speak and conflict
10 with a regular meeting. This is not considered a
11 meeting in furtherance of the Convention work, because
12 it is not in Annapolis?

13 DELEGATE SCANLAN: My original reaction to
14 that would be no, that would not be a session of the
15 committee or sub-committee or a session of the
16 Convention. On the other hand, I suppose in an important
17 meeting, where the Convention or a committee of the
18 Convention felt that the rules, it was more important
19 that one or two of the members went to such a meeting
20 and spoke, it seems to me it would not take any great
21 deal of ingenuity for a committee chairman pursuant to
