2 be worked out to everybody's satisfaction.

3 THE PRESIDENT: Further questions? Delegate  
4 Chabot?

5 DELEGATE CHABOT: With regard to 70(c),  
6 illness of the delegate, is that illness to the delegate  
7 only or does that pertain to the immediate family  
8 situation?

9 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I would take it to mean  
10 the illness of one's wife or the illness of a child  
11 requiring the presence of a father, if not covered in  
12 that section, certainly could be reached by the last  
13 phrase, factors beyond the delegate's control.

14 DELEGATE CHABOT: How would that rule be  
15 applied in situations where the Convention itself was  
16 not meeting and many of the committees were not meeting  
17 and other committees were meeting?

18 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I believe if a committee  
19 were meeting, pursuant to call of its chairman pursuing  
20 the business on a Saturday, the man would be entitled  
21 to his \$25 for attendance.
