

1 DELEGATE CHABOT: If he were not at that
2 meeting presumably he would have the \$15 penalty, but
3 other members of the Convention who were not in that
4 committee would have neither the \$25 nor the \$15 penalty?

5 DELEGATE SCANLAN: That inequity could
6 arise. I think again by conversation between members
7 of the committee and the chairman who call the
8 Sunday afternoon meeting the inequities could be
9 eliminated.

10 DELEGATE CHABOT: One more question, if I
11 may. Would absences because of religious obligations
12 be expected to be regarded as excused absences?

13 DELEGATE SCANLAN: Yes. As a matter of
14 fact, I think this was brought up earlier in some of
15 the informal discussions before the committee and the
16 view was unanimous that absence because of a religious
17 obligation certainly would be using, again, this phrase,
18 in an awkward but liberal sense, a factor beyond the
19 delegate's control.
