pick up your pay for the short day after the time had run out?

DELEGATE SCANLAN: I don't think the committee allowed for an evening out process. If the man was absent with an excused absence, he doesn't lose \$15 but he loses \$25 for that day. I don't think he can make it up by the claim, well, he worked harder in the last, the fourth month of the Convention. Similarly, if he lost his \$15 for an unexcused absence, I don't see how he could make it up. I think this would be fairly rare.

THE PRESIDENT: I am not sure, Delegate

Scanlan, but I don't think that was the intent of Delegate

Stern's question, if I understood him myself. I think

he was asking whether if a delegate by reason of his

having missed time early in the session had not reached

his \$4,500 limit, could he collect for attendance

subsequently that did not carry him over the \$4500, even

though such attendance for other delegates might be

non-compensatory.
