2 The proposal for this amendment, as you know,
3 originated with Delegate Robey, who introduced it in
4 the Convention last week. There were a number of other
5 delegates who supported Delegate Robey's proposal.
6 Delegate Robey appeared three times, I believe, before
7 the Committee on Rules, Credentials and Convention Budget
8 to explain his proposal to the Committee. In addition,
9 at one of the sessions of the Committee we were favored
10 by the President, who came and explained some of the
11 problems in the public information area, and what the
12 officers of the Convention were doing in an attempt to co-
13 operate with them.

14 Delegate Robey brought to the attention of the
15 Committee a precedent, numerous precedents in other
16 Constitutional Conventions; and some of these are set
17 forth in the Appendix, which is attached to the Fifth
18 Report. The Michigan Constitution is interesting. How-
19 ever, I think they went further than your Committee wishes
20 to go in recommending a Committee on Public Information.
