

1 Committee on Public Information thinking that it would
2 be a good idea. Obviously, the Committee on Public
3 Information would introduce a resolution supported by
4 a report, recommending that this policy with respect to
5 TV be reversed and that TV be permitted, and the matter
6 would be put to the Convention; and in that respect the
7 Committee could have an appeal to the Convention. I
8 mention that as purely hypothetical, but I thought the
9 hypothetical was not too far removed from the context
10 of the situation we are discussing.

11 So with that understanding of the purpose of
12 the Committee, we have recommended favorably the creation
13 of a Committee on Public Information. It is not, however,
14 to be an administrative committee. It is to be an ad-
15 visory committee, to assist in recommending general policy
16 to the officers and to the Convention with respect to
17 public information.
