

1 between the officers and the Committee, then the Committee's
2 real difficulty would be to deal with the Convention in
3 regular committee procedural channels.

4 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: It is not the intent of the
5 Committee, however, that the Committee would report back,
6 as the standing committees now do, unless there was some
7 manner of dispute?

8 DELEGATE SCANLAN: No. It would be regarded
9 as a procedural committee. It is more related to procedure
10 than substance. It is somewhat like the Rules Committee
11 in that respect. For example, if the members of my Com-
12 mittee felt strongly about the procedure under a rule,
13 it perhaps could be taken care of without changing the
14 rules. We might suggest that to the officers. They could
15 reject it. If we felt strongly enough about it, we could
16 bring it to this Convention in the form of recommended
17 action in the Committee Report. Similarly, the Committee
18 on Public Information could do that.

19 DELEGATE WHEATLEY: This Committee, like any
20 committee, would cease at the end of the Convention?

21 DELEGATE SCANLAN: I believe it would.
