3 May I suggest to the delegates who are interested
4 in keeping track of the amendments, that the Fifth Report
5 is dated September 22, 1967, which is the date it was
6 filed by the Committee with the Clerk. It was first
7 presented to you today. If you want to note the dates,
8 you can do so in pen and ink. Thank you, Delegate Scan-
9 lan.

10 The next item of business is the introduction
11 and first reading of proposals.

12 There are twenty-two proposals today, Nos. 140
13 to 161, inclusive. Delegate Proposal No. 140. The
14 Clerk will read the proposal.

15 MR. QUILLEN: Delegate Proposal No. 140,
16 by Delegate Finch, A proposal that a provision be added
17 to the Constitution gradually reducing the voting age
18 from 21 years to 18 years on a graduated scale of one
19 year reduction age every four years starting in 1968.

20 THE PRESIDENT: Delegate Proposal No. 140 is
21 referred to the Committee on Suffrage and Elections.
