by saying Aye; contrary, No. The Ayes have it. It is 1 2 so ordered. May I suggest to the delegates who are interested 3 in keeping track of the amendments, that the Fifth Report is dated September 22, 1967, which is the date it was 5 filed by the Committee with the Clerk. It was first presented to you today. If you want to note the dates, you can do so in pen and ink. Thank you, Delegate Scanlan.
