2 "My very best wishes to you and all of the
3 Delegates to the Constitutional Convention as you begin
4 this project so vital to our State's interests. I regret
5 that my attendance at the Southern Government^{CRS}~~ments~~ Conference
6 precludes my being with you²⁴ present, but my thoughts are
7 with you in this historic undertaking, and I look forward
8 to being with you soon. Good luck. Spiro T. Agnew,
9 Governor."

10 I might add that I have written to the Governor
11 formally and also conferred with him privately, and on
12 behalf of the Convention, extended to him an invitation
13 to address the Convention, to submit to it any suggestions
14 which he may have for consideration by the Convention,
15 or to mention to the Convention any problems of the State
16 Government which he deems appropriate. The Governor has
17 indicated that he will do so, and appropriate arrangements
18 will be made for this, probably within the next ten days.
