4 condition?

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Key.

6 DELEGATE KEY: These are the kind of things we
7 hope to give the legislature courage to act upon.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Koger.

9 DELEGATE KOGER: We have a situation where a
10 man had \$1200 worth of awnings put up, and, as a result,
11 he had a bill for \$11,000 some-odd. In other words, he
12 lost his home. Would conditions of that kind be covered?

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Delegate Key.

14 DELEGATE KEY: The legislature would have the
15 mandate to take care of it.
