4 THE CHAIRMAN: For what purpose does Delegate
5 Storm rise?

6 DELEGATE STORM: Would she yield to a question?

7 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you yield?

8 DELEGATE MAURER: I want to -- I will yield,
9 if I may finish two sentences.

10 THE CHAIRMAN: She will yield later, she wants
11 to finish two sentences.

12 DELEGATE MAURER: Under the proposed Committee
13 Report the legislature will be able to organize and
14 reorganize the agencies and departments, and while this is
15 important, the crucial element, the element of executive
16 authority, commensurate with executive responsibility,
17 will be placed beyond the reach of ordinary law.

18 I urge you to support the Committee Report and
19 to vote against the amendment.

20 THE CHAIRMAN: I am afraid your time has become
