

1           Postage for the Delegates is available for you.  
2           Each Delegate will be allowed a maximum of \$25 of postage  
3           through the session. That is not available at the moment,  
4           but you will be able to get two rolls, \$10 of postage  
5           simply by stopping at Mr. Martineau's office. Mr. Mar-  
6           tineau is occupying the office normally occupied by the  
7           Clerk of the House.

8           Harbor Tunnel passage for Delegates can be ob-  
9           tained. Any Delegate who lives in an area of the City or  
10          County which requires him, or if it makes it more conven-  
11          ient for him to use the Harbor Tunnel, may secure passage  
12          if he will see Mr. Martineau.

13          I.D. cards will be prepared for each Delegate.  
14          It is necessary that you go to have a small photograph  
15          taken. If you will do this as promptly as possible,  
16          certainly today or tomorrow, by going to the Alcohol  
17          Beverage Division at the State Office Building.

18          I stand corrected. You cannot do it today.  
19          Today is a holiday; so you will have to do it tomorrow  
20          or the next day.
